Facility

Located on the University of Indianapolis campus, the Athletic Recreational Center (ARC) has eight lanes for short sprints and hurdles, six oval lanes for distance events, and relays. The facility also has two long jump runways, two pole vault runways, a high jump area, and a netted throwing area.

Entries

Entries must be submitted through Direct Athletics – www.directathletics.com. Visiting teams can enter 2 athletes in the 60-meter dash, 60-meter hurdles, and 3200-meter run. Visiting teams will be limited to 2 athletes in ALL field events and 1 relay team (4x200m, 4x400m, 4x800m, and Distance Medley). The performance list and start list will be available on the day of the competition,

Scratches

Scratches will be accepted at the scorer's table before the start of the competition. Meet management will only make change names if an athlete qualifies for the HSR Finals. Coaches must contact meet management before the conclusion of the meet.

Opening heights

This is a qualifying meet for the HSR Championships, opening heights are set to help those athletes trying to achieve the qualifying mark. If you have a developing athlete who doesn't have a chance to make opening height, please do not enter them

Pole Vault: Girls starting height is 7-0 with 6-inch increments to 9-6 then 3-inch increments
Boys starting height 10-6 with 6-inch increments to 12-6 then 3-inch increments

High Jump: Girls starting height is 4-6 with 2-inch increments to 5-0 then 1-inch increments
Boys starting height is 5-6 with 2-inch increments to 6-2 then 1-inch increments
